#### Addressed issues

#### Installation

Upgrading FileMaker Server to 19.4.1 using the Amazon Web Services (AWS) System
Manager for a silent install on an AWS instance caused these issues: The credentials for
accessing Admin Console didn't work, serverCustom.pem was deleted,
and dbs\_config.xml was reset to default.

# Security

 When an ECC P-384 SSL certificate was used for FileMaker Server, Claris FileMaker Pro® and Claris FileMaker Go® were unable to securely connect to custom apps using fully qualified domain names.

# **Features**

- Claris FileMaker WebDirect®: Merge fields briefly displayed internal string IDs before rendering the correct content.
- When calling the Perform Script on Server script step, the script session could not be disconnected in Admin Console if the running script changed the session identifier with the Set Session Identifier script step.

# APIs, technologies, or features to be deprecated

As FileMaker Server evolves, the list of supported technologies, APIs, and features will change. As part of this evolution, certain operating systems versions, hardware, and features may be deprecated in favor of newer ones. Although deprecation does not mean the immediate deletion
