Addressed issues

- Under certain conditions, the FileMaker Server Script Engine stopped responding when using calculations to access container data.
- The Replace Field Contents script step was much slower in version 19.5.1 than in previous versions.
- In some cases, field validation incorrectly displayed a warning message for empty repeating fields or fields that were not modified.
- Ubuntu 20.04: FileMaker Server stopped responding when sending SMTP emails.
- PDFs being generated in a hidden background file didn't calculate an object's visibility correctly.
- In version 19.5.1, the Quote function was modified to handle line feeds the same way as carriage returns. This change caused existing calculations to return different, unexpected results. Previous functionality has been restored.

Known issues

 Ubuntu: After upgrading FileMaker Server on Ubuntu 20.04 for both primary and secondary machines, the database icons and streaming container data fail to load in FileMaker WebDirect until primary and secondary machines are disconnected and reconnected.

Note: For information on adding and removing secondary machines, run the following command-line command:

WinsoftINTERNATIONAL

fmsadmin HELP WPE
