

# Claris FileMaker Server 19.5.3 Release Notes

September 2022

### New features and enhancements

OpenSSL has been upgraded to version 1.1.1q.

### Addressed issues

- Ubuntu: FileMaker Server failed to start if the "libcurl3-gnutls" library was not installed before installing FileMaker Server.
- For group name matching, the Get ( AccountName ) function returned blank for custom OAuth identity providers instead of a valid account name when the email was blank in the response token.
- Ubuntu: When using Apache on Ubuntu 20.04, if FileMaker Server was upgraded without first stopping the service, the installation stopped and incorrectly referenced Nginx instead of Apache.
- Windows: Admin Console credentials became invalid after upgrading FileMaker Server if there were several hosted large files.
- FileMaker Server intermittently experienced the following issues:
  - FileMaker Server stopped responding during scheduled backups and validations.
  - Closing databases in Admin Console took over five minutes, even when no clients were connected.
  - Database files failed to reopen after backup verification during a scheduled backup.
  - FileMaker Server stopped responding during midnight automatic backups.
- The fmodata.log file stored the incorrect timestamp for OData activity.



- The OData process stopped responding when non-OData requests were routed to the OData process.
- Ubuntu: Upgrading FileMaker Server on a multiple-machine deployment caused custom database icons and interactive container data to no longer display in Claris FileMaker WebDirect.
- macOS: Upgrade installations of FileMaker Server used the "fmserver" user, even if previous installations used a different user account.
- FileMaker WebDirect: The Send Email script step failed when using a multi-machine deployment.

#### **Known issues**

 Ubuntu: Installation on Ubuntu 18.04 incorrectly references HTTP Nginx Server. The only web server supported on Ubuntu 18.04 is Apache.

## APIs, technologies, or features to be deprecated

As FileMaker Server evolves, the list of supported technologies, APIs, and features will change. As part of this evolution, certain operating systems versions, hardware, and features may be deprecated in favor of newer ones. Although deprecation does not mean the immediate deletion of an item, you should migrate your solution away from deprecated technologies, because these technologies may be removed in a future version of the product.
