

Claris FileMaker Pro 22.0.2 Release Notes

September 2025

This software updates FileMaker Pro to version 2025 (22.0.2) and addresses issues. If you are unable to successfully update to FileMaker Pro 2025 (22.0.2), search the Knowledge Base for installation information.

New features and enhancements

Improvements for upgrading and starting FileMaker Pro in Windows

• FileMaker Pro 2025 and FileMaker Pro 2024 can now be used on the same system at the same time. If FileMaker Pro 2024 is installed, you can use Help > Check for Updates to upgrade to FileMaker Pro 2025 (version 22.0.2) or separately download and run the version 22.0.2 updater. Either way, you're now asked whether you want to keep the previous version. If you choose to keep it, the previous version is copied to a new location and a shortcut to it is added to the desktop, then FileMaker Pro 2024 in its original location is upgraded to 2025.

Note The full installer for FileMaker Pro 2025 (version 22.0.2) doesn't offer the option to keep the previous version. For this option, you must use Help > Check for Updates or the downloadable updater.

• FileMaker Pro now saves product information to a shared location instead of the Windows registry, eliminating the need for administrator privileges and preventing unnecessary User Access Control prompts when starting the application.

Addressed issues

Layouts

- Conditional formatting that checked for empty values didn't work correctly in fields that contained placeholder text.
- In Layout mode, the Inspector incorrectly displayed the same icon for both moving objects forward as well as backward in stacking order.

Script steps

- FileMaker Pro quit unexpectedly when executing a Generate Response from Model script step with both the **Stream** option and **Perform JavaScript in Web Viewer** option turned on.
- The Go to List of Records script step caused FileMaker Pro to quit unexpectedly when provided with a list containing empty string values in certain positions—for example, ["3","","1"].
- When the Set Al Call Logging script step was turned **On** and **Verbose** was **On**, detailed content and context data was unnecessarily included in the Al call log.
