This software updates FileMaker Pro to version 2025 (22.0.7) and addresses issues. If you are unable to successfully update to FileMaker Pro 2025 (22.0.7), search the Knowledge Base for installation information.

New features and enhancements

Security updates

- Windows: When you sign out of a Claris ID account, an additional dialog is no longer displayed, simplifying the sign-out process.
- The following third-party libraries have been updated to the indicated versions:
 - OpenSSL 3.5.7 LTS
 - libcurl 8.20.0

Addressed issues

- If a client force-quit FileMaker Pro or disconnected from FileMaker WebDirect while the Delete Account script step was running, the affected file could become locked and fail to open, security modifications would display a message indicating another user was modifying the items, and file verification would fail with error 808.
- Windows: FileMaker Pro stopped responding after you navigated to a layout whose base table was an Oracle database table connected as an external SQL data source, then signed in to the data source, regardless of whether the credentials were correct.
