

Claris FileMaker Server 22.0.7 Release Notes

August 2026

This software updates FileMaker Server 2025 (22.0.7), adds new features and enhancements, and addresses issues.

FileMaker Server 22.0.7 is available as a full installer, which can also upgrade or update an existing installation.

New features and enhancements

Security updates

- Apache Tomcat has been upgraded to version 10.1.54.
- Node.js has been updated to version 22.23.1.
- The OpenSSL library has been updated to version 3.5.7.
- The libcurl library has been updated to version 8.20.0.

Authentication

- FileMaker Server now supports Proof Key for Code Exchange (PKCE) for Microsoft Entra ID (Azure AD) external authentication. This update also resolves a 404 error that occurred on Windows during the redirect after authenticating with Microsoft Entra ID, which prevented guest and external users from signing in via FileMaker WebDirect and FileMaker Pro.
- If a client force-quit FileMaker Pro or disconnected from FileMaker WebDirect while the Delete Account script step was running, the affected file could become locked and fail to open, security modifications would display a message indicating another user was modifying the items, and file verification would fail with error 808.

Addressed issues

FileMaker Script Engine (FMSE)

- FMSE quit unexpectedly during scheduled script execution, causing databases to become unusable until the server was restarted.
- FMSE terminated abnormally with Event ID 760 when running multiple scheduled scripts, particularly in configurations where scheduled scripts on one server executed scripts hosted on a separate server.

General

- After upgrading to FileMaker Server 22, container field contents loaded significantly slower or timed out entirely when FileMaker Pro clients connected using HTTPS tunneling.

- In some cases, FileMaker Server quit unexpectedly due to a race condition caused by the session map not being properly locked when handling timed out and FileMaker WebDirect sessions.
- Windows: The Admin Server process quit unexpectedly when navigating to the Connectors tab in Admin Console while a custom SSL certificate was installed.

APIs, technologies, or features to be deprecated

As FileMaker Server evolves, the list of supported technologies, APIs, and features will change. As part of this evolution, certain operating systems versions, hardware, and features may be deprecated in favor of newer ones. Although deprecation does not mean the immediate deletion of an item, you should migrate your solution away from deprecated technologies, because these technologies may be removed in a future version of the product.
